2. Cách dùng:

 - e.g.: His father worked in a factory for 10 years.
- sự kiện xảy ra đồng thời, hay sau hành động khác, hoặc nhiều hành động xảy ra liên tiếp trong quá khứ.
 - e.g.: He studied English when he was in London.

II. STRUCTURE: CLAUSES AFTER WISH

Ex: She wanted to have more time to know Viet Nam better. She might say

→ "I wish I had more time to know Viet Nam better..."

FORM: S_1 + wish(es) + S_2 + Past simple tense

S+V2/V-ed (Negative: S+didn't+V base form) Be \Rightarrow were (not be \Rightarrow weren't)

→ To express wish (something unlikely to happen)

* OTHER STRUCTURES:

1. IT'S (ABOUT) TIME/ IT'S HIGH TIME FOR + SO + TO V....

= IT'S (ABOUT) TIME/ IT'S HIGH TIME + S + V2/ Ved.

EX: It's (high) time for you to go to bed = It's (high) time you went to bed.

2.WOULD RATHER / 'D RATHER + QKĐ

EX: I'd rather you didn't smoke here.

$$S+V2/V-ed$$
 (Negative: $S+didn't+V$ base form)
Be \Rightarrow were (not be \Rightarrow weren't)

→ To express wish (something unlikely to happen)

1. IT'S (ABOUT) TIME/ IT'S HIGH TIME = IT'S (ABOUT) TIME/ IT'S HIGH TIME EX: It's (high) time for you to go to bed = 2.WOULD RATHER / 'D RATHER EX: I'd rather you didn't smoke here.
