President of America

Donald Trump is an American businessman and the President-elect of the United States. He is scheduled to take office as the 45th President on January 20, 2017. He was born on June 14, 1946, in Jamaica Estates, Queens, a neighborhood in New York City. He was the second youngest child of five children. Trump left the school at the age of 13 and was enrolled

in the New York Military Academy (NYMA), where he finished eighth grade and high school. Trump attended Fordham University in the Bronx for two years, beginning in August 1964. While there, he worked at the family's company, Trump graduated from Wharton in May 1968 with a Bachelor of Science in Economics. In 2003, Trump became the executive producer and host of the NBC reality show "The Apprentice", in which a group of competitors battled for a high-level management job in one of Trump's commercial enterprises. In June 2015, Trump announced his candidacy for president as a Republican and quickly emerged as the front-runner for his party's nomination. On November 8, 2016, he defeated

Hillary Clinton in the general election and became the 45thPresident of America after the pre-president Barack Obama.
