#### **II. Grammar:**

##### **1. Present Simple for future use:**

- We can use the Present Simple to talk about things we know will definitely happen in the future, such as timetables or programs for shops, movie theaters, restaurants, or public transport
- Example:
  - a. The **festival starts** at 6 p.m.
  - b. The **festival ends** at 10 p.m.
  - c. **The food stands open** at 5.30 p.m.
  - d. **They close** at 10:30 p.m.
  - e. **The bus leaves** in ten minutes.
  - f. What time does **the music performance start**?
  - g. Does **the festival start** in the morning? (→ Yes, **it does.**/ No, **it doesn't.**)

##### **NOTE:**

- We say events and activities **start** and **end**.  
*Example: The talent show **starts** at 3 p.m. and **ends** at 4.30 p.m.*
- We say shops, stands, and restaurants **open** and **close**.  
*Example: The food stand **opens** at 11 a.m. and **closes** at 3 p.m.*
