### A. Grammar:

#### I. Simple present tense for WH-question (Thì Hiện tại đơn với câu hỏi WH)

	<b>WH- questions asking for object (Loại câu hỏi để tìm Tân ngữ)</b>	<b>WH-questions asking for subject (Loại câu hỏi để tìm chủ ngữ)</b>
<b>Example</b>	a. What <u>housework</u> <u>do</u> you do? → I <u>clean</u> the house. b. What <u>housework</u> <u>does</u> she do? → She <u>does</u> the dishes.	a. Who <u>does</u> the laundry? → I <u>do</u> the laundry. b. Who <u>makes</u> the dinner? → My brother <u>makes</u> the dinner.
<b>Formation (Công thức)</b>	<b>Question word + N + do/does + S + V?</b> → <b>S + Vbare/ Vs/ Ves + O.</b>	<b>Question word + Vs/ Ves + N?</b> → <b>S + Vbare/ Vs/ Ves + O.</b>

#### II. Possessive 's (Sở hữu cách)

- You can add '**S** to a noun or proper noun. (Chúng ta có thể thêm 's vào sau một danh từ hay danh từ riêng để mang nghĩa sở hữu.)

Ex: Ken's father (ba của Ken)  
Tom's sister (chị gái của Tom)  
the girl's story (câu chuyện của cô gái)
