



We use the **Present Simple** to talk about things we know will definitely happen in the future, such as timetables or programs for shops, movie theaters, restaurants, or public transport, etc.

The festival starts at 6 p.m. The festival ends at 10 p.m. The food stands open at 5:30 p.m. They close at 10:30 p.m. The bus leaves in ten minutes.

What time does the music performance start? Does the festival start in the morning? (Yes, it does./No, it doesn't.)

- We say events and activities **start** and **end**. The talent show **starts** at 3 p.m. and **ends** at 4:30 p.m.
- We say shops, stands, and restaurants open and close. The food stand opens at 11 a.m. and closes at 3 p.m.
