



This/That: for singular nouns These/Those: for plural nouns

This/These: for things close to the speaker That/Those: for things further away

How much is this T-shirt?

Do you have that shirt in blue?

How much are those shoes over there?

Do you have these socks in green?

Object Pronouns _ it // them __

We use Object Pronouns after a verb or a preposition. We use it for singular nouns and them for plural nouns.


