Demonstratives

We use **this/that/these/those** to show which things we are talking about.

This/That: for singular nouns

These/Those: for plural nouns

This/These: for things close to the speaker

That/Those: for things further away

How much is **this** T-shirt?

Do you have **that** shirt in blue?

How much are **those** shoes over there?

Do you have **these** socks in green?

Object Pronouns: "it"/"them"

We use **Object Pronouns** after a verb or a preposition.

We use **it** for singular nouns and **them** for plural nouns.

I like this jacket. Do you have **it** in blue?

I like these pants. Can I try **them** on?

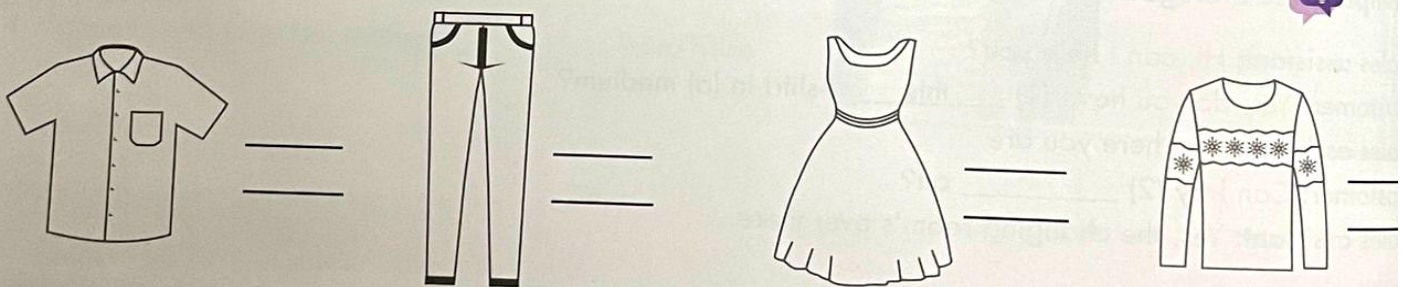


