

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**LESSON 2-2 (Grammar)**

**I. Conjunction: Because**

- Because can be used as a conjunction to connect two clauses in a sentence. The because-clause can come first or second in the sentence

- Because is used for showing the reason something happens. It is used to answer the question: "Why?"

Ex: I failed my exam because I didn't study hard

Ex: Because I didn't study hard, I failed my exam.

Ex: Why are you annoyed ? - Because I lost my English book

**II. Adverbs: So and Really**

- We use So and really to make adjectives stronger.

- So is generally used before an adverb or adjective.

Ex: He's **so** happy because he got an A on math homework

Ex: She plays the piano **so** well

- Really can be used before adjectives or some verbs

Ex: My teacher was **really** surprised because I passed all my tests

Ex: I **really** want to go home now
