


Grammar notes :

- A. "want" = "would like" (muốn)
- Ex : 1. I want to buy a bottle of cooking oil.
  - $\rightarrow$  I would like to buy a bottle of cooking oil.
    - 2. She wants some milk.
    - $\rightarrow~$  She would like some milk.
- S Negative form : (thể phủ định)

1. I don't want to buy a bottle of cooking oil.

- $\rightarrow$  I would not like to buy a bottle of cooking oil.
  - 2. She doesn't wants any milk.
  - $\rightarrow\,$  She would not like any milk.

- S Interrogative form : (thể nghi vấn)
- 1. Do you want to buy a bottle of cooking oil ?.
- $\rightarrow$  Would you like to buy a bottle of cooking oil ?.
  - 2. She doesn't wants any milk ?.
  - $\rightarrow$  She would not like any milk ?.
- B. Asking about the price : (hỏi về giá cả)



Ex : How much is this hat?

 $\rightarrow$  It's twenty thousand dong.
