2. Would rather : muốn, thích

a/ S + would rather (not)+ V ...

e.g: I would rather eat a hamburger.

He would rather not drink coffee.

b/ S1 + would rather + S2 + V2/ed ...

didn't + V

e.g: Our teacher would rather we went to class on time.

e.g: Our teacher would rather we didn't come to class late.

c/ S + would rather + V... + than + V ...

e.g: He would rather watch TV than listen to music.

4. used to : đã từng

USED TO + V

e.g: I used to play sports a lot when I was a student.

e.g. There used to be a big building in my neighborhood.

5. be / get used to : quen với

BE / GET USED TO + V-ING

e.g: We are used to walking to school.

e.g: He gets used to staying up late.
