⇒ S + V(s/es) + .....+ danh từ số ít ( dt ko đếm được)

**How much + danh từ số nhiều**( dt đếm được) + do/ does + S + V....?

⇒ S + V(s/es) + .....+ danh từ số nhiều ( dt đếm được)

**Lưu ý:** trợ động từ “ do/ does” là phụ thuộc vào chủ ngữ.

EX: 1. How much rice does your mother want?

She wants 2 kilos of rice.

2. How many books do you want to buy?

I want to buy 5 books.
