=> **On the left are the shelves of Math and Science books.**

d) What books are on the right?

=> **On the right there are the shelves of History and Geography books, dictionaries and Literature in Vietnamese.**

e) Where are the books in English?

=> **The books in English are at the back of the library.**

f) What time does the library open?

=> **The library opens at 7 am.**

g) What time does it close?

=> **It closes at half past 4.30 pm.**

## 2. Listen. Then practice with a partner.

=> **They're English books, novels, dictionaries and reference books.**
