The Summary of *Charlotte's Web*

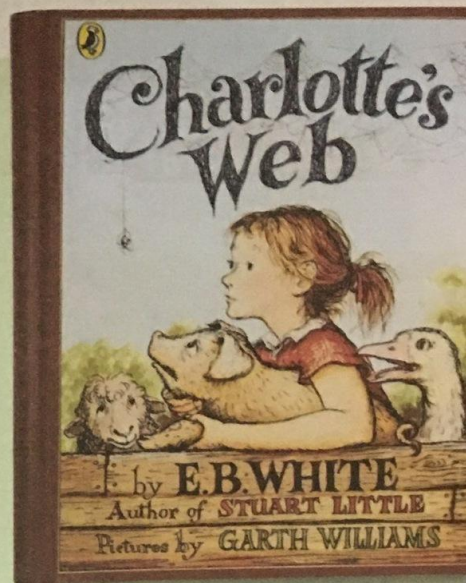
Alex Woods, July 27

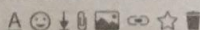
