## ★ FORMING ADVERBS FROM ADJECTIVES:

Adverbs describe Verbs or other Adverbs. They can describe *manner* (how), *place* (where), *time* (when), *frequency* (how often).

✓ We add –*ly* to the Adjectives to form Adverbs.

Ex: excited (adj) => excited ly (adv); real (adj) => real ly (adv)

✓ Adjectives ending in -*le* => drop the –*e* and take –*y*.

Ex: comfortable (Adj) => comfortably (adv), simple (adj) => simply (adv)

✓ Adjectives ending in *consonant* + *y* => drop the −*y* and take −*ily*.

Ex: hap**py** (adj) => happ**ily** (adv), ea**sy** (adj) => eas**ily** 

✓ <u>Note</u>: Irregular Adverbs:

Good => **well**, fast => **fast**, hard => **hard**
