II. COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

Short adjectives: (1 vowel)

Ex: Ho Chi Minh City is **bigger than** Ha Noi.

Long adjectives

Ex: French is **more difficult than** English.

% Special cases

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good → better

bad → worse

far → farther / further

much / many → more
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- With some 2-syllable adjectives, we can use "-ER" or "MORE"

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Ex: quiet → quieter / more quiet
clever → cleverer / more clever
narrow → narrower / more narrow
simple → simpler / more simple
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- If the adjective ends in -E, we add -R. Ex: (safe \rightarrow safer)
- One syllable adjective endings with vowel and one consonant, we double the consonant. Ex: $(big \rightarrow bigger)$
- Final -Y changes to -IER. (pretty \rightarrow prettier)
