1. Laundry (n)	/ˈləʊndri/	Công việc giặt ủi <i>There was a pile of clean <u>laundry</u> on her bed.</i>
2. Dinner (n)	/ˈdɪnə(r)/	Bữa ăn tối <i>Let's invite them to <u>dinner</u> tomorrow.</i>
3. Kitchen (n)	/ˈkɪtʃɪn/	Nhà bếp <i>We ate at the <u>kitchen</u> table.</i>
4. Shopping (n)	/ˈʃɒpɪŋ/	Mua sắm tại cửa hàng hoặc mua sắm trực tuyến <i>I do all my clothes <u>shopping</u> online.</i>
5. Dish (n)	/dɪʃ/	Cái đĩa (Dishes : Chén đĩa) <i>I'll do the dishes</i>
6. Clean (V)	/kli:n/	(Dọn dẹp/Làm sạch/Sạch sẽ) <i>Keep your room neat and <u>clean</u>.</i>
7. Housework (n)	/ˈhaʊswɜ:k/	(Công việc nhà) <i>To do the <u>housework</u></i>
8. Breakfast (n)	/ˈhaʊswɜ:k/	Bữa ăn sáng <i>She doesn't eat much <u>breakfast</u>.</i>

GRAMMAR:

Present Simple with Wh- question:

We use the Simple Present and WH-question to ask about things that are facts.

- What + Noun + do/does + Subject + Verb 0 + ...?

Ex: What housework do you do at home?

- Who + V(s/es) + Noun?

Ex: Who does the shopping?

→ My mother does shopping.

Short answer: My mother.
