#### I. WILL and WON'T in the first conditional

- Câu điều kiện loại I diễn tả sự việc có thể xảy ra ở hiện tại hoặc tương lai theo như điều kiện được đặt ra.

<b>If clause</b> (Mệnh đề điều kiện)	Main clause (Mệnh đề chính)	
If $+ S + V_{(s/es)}$ ,	S + will/ can/ may + V-inf	

Positive form (Thể khẳng định)	E.g: If it rains, I will wear a raincoat.  Luu ý: Mệnh đề will có thể đặt trước và không dùng dấu phẩy.  We will have bright future if we study hard.
Negative form (Thể phủ định)	E.g: Will they wait if we come late?
<b>Question form</b> (Thể nghi vấn)	<b>E.g:</b> If they don't ban cars in the city, air pollution won't decrease.

Lưu ý: Mệnh đề will có thể đặt trước và không dùng dấu phẩy.

#### II. MUST AND SHOULD

**Cấu trúc chung:** S + **must/ should** (not) + V (bare infinitive)

#### Should/Shouldn't

- Hỏi xin và đưa ra lời khuyên
- You should drink more water.
- Should we go out tonight?

#### Must – phải làm gì

- Người nói thấy bản thân, ai phải làm gì (quan điểm cá nhân tác nhân bên trong)
- I must study harder for the final exam.

#### Mustn't – cấm làm gì

• You mustn't enter this room.
